
- TEMPLATE I PRINTED ONTO
 BLUE CARD
- TEMPLATE 2 PRINTED ONTO BROWN CARD
- SCISSORS
- TAPE




STEP 1: CUT ALONG WAVE LINES ON TEMPLATE 1



STEP 2: CUT MIDDLE LINE



STEP 3: FOLD TEMPLATE IN HALF ALONG DOTTED LINE



STEP 4: FOLD ALONG THE DOTTED LINE AT THE EDGE OF THE WAVE, WHILST KEEPING THE WAVE STRAIGHT



STEP 5: REPEAT FOR THE OTHER SIDE



STEP 6: CUT OUT A BOAT FROM TEMPLATE 2



STEP 7: CUT ALONG THE MIDDLE LINE OF THE TAB




STEP 8: SLIDE TAB INTO MIDDLE SLIT OF TEMPLATE I




STEP 9: FOLD TAB IN TWO AND STICK ON EACH SIDE UNDERNEATH USING TAPE



THE PROMISE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

JOHN 16:5-15



THIS COULD ALSO BE USED TO TEACH: DAY OF PENTECOST; BURNING BUSH (CUT OUT GREEN PAPER LEAVES AND STICK THEM ON THE INSIDE OF THE FLAMES)

YOU WILL NEED:

- CLEAR PLASTIC BOTTLE (EG 2 LITRE SODA BOTTLE OR TRANSPARENT PLASTIC CUP)
- SCISSORS
- FELT PEN (EG SHARPIE)
- PAPER
- WHITE CRAFT GLUE
- GLUE SPREADER
- PAPER PLATE
- YELLOW, ORANGE AND RED COLOURED TISSUE PAPER
- TAPE
- PRINTED TEMPLATE



STEP 1: PRINT TEMPLATE ONTO PAPER AND CUT IT OUT



STEP 3: DRAW AROUND TEMPLATE ONTO BOTTLE USING FELT PEN



STEP 2: WRAP TEMPLATE AROUND THE BOTTLE. USE TAPE TO HOLD IT IN PLACE



STEP 4: CUT AROUND DRAWN OUTLINE TO MAKE FIRE SHAPE



STEP 5: SPREAD WHITE GLUE DIRECTLY ONTO THE PLASTIC

TIP: DON'T GLUE THE WHOLE THING AT ONCE, GLUE IT IN SMALLER SECTIONS AND LAY ON THE TISSUE AS YOU GO



STEP 6: WRAP RED, ORANGE AND YELLOW TISSUE AROUND THE PLASTIC

REMEMBER THE BOTTOM OF THE FLAME IS RED, THE MIDDLE IS OR-ANGE AND THE TIPS ARE YELLOW



STEP 7: GLUE OVER THE SURFACE OF THE TISSUE PAPER TO SMOOTH THE ROUGH EDGES DOWN
