

THE PARABLE OF THE LOST SHEEP

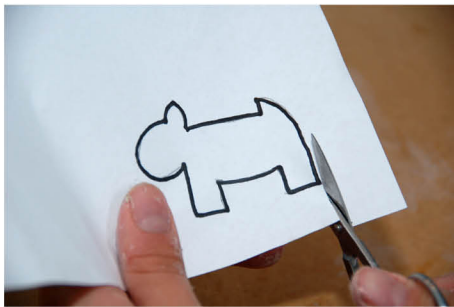
THIS CRAFT CAN ALSO BE USED TO TEACH

YOU WILL NEED:

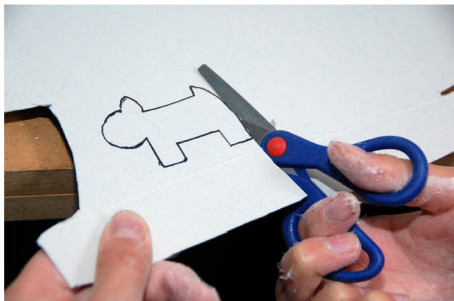
- CEREAL BOX
- BLACK PAINT
- SPONGE/PAINTBRUSH
- PAPER PLATE FOR PAINT PALETTE
- WHITE WOOL
- PRINTED TEMPLATE ONTO PAPER
- SCISSORS
- FELT PEN



STEP 1: CUT OUT PRINTED
TEMPLATE



STEP 2: LAY THE TEMPLATE
ONTO CARDBOARD AND DRAW
AROUND IT



STEP 3: CUT OUT THE SHAPE
DRAWN ONTO THE CEREAL BOX



STEP 4: USE SMALL SCISSORS
TO CUT A SLIT JUST BEFORE THE
TAIL



STEP 5: USE SPONGE OR BRUSH TO PAINT THE SHEEP BLACK ON BOTH SIDES



STEP 6: CUT A PIECE OF WOOL APPROXIMATELY 50 CMS LONG AND TIE ONE END AROUND THE WHOLE BODY OF THE SHEEP



STEP 7: KEEP WRAPPING THE WOOL ALL OVER THE BODY OF THE SHEEP AS IF IT WERE A COTTON REEL



STEP 8: WHEN THE WOOL RUNS OUT, TUCK THE END INTO THE SLIT NEXT TO ITS TAIL

PREPARE STEPS 1 TO 4**

**FOR A SHORTER SESSION
STILL: PREPARE STEP 5**
